The **Juneau Pro-Choice Coalition (JPCC)** and **Picture This** gallery at 230 S. Franklin Street #110 in downtown Juneau are calling all artists to participate in an upcoming art show -- **FREEDOM FOR ALL** – a fundraising sale at the gallery Friday, June 6, opening at 4pm.

Picture This will host the show starting May 30, and will show all artisans' handmade works through First Friday, June 6, when the works will be for purchase by show patrons. Pieces not sold June 6 will show through June or until sold, whichever comes first.

The proceeds from the show go to the JPCC's annual scholarship fund which supports local high school seniors, college students and adult learners with continuing education.

This **FREEDOM FOR ALL** art show is a fun way for artists to support the JPCC's local annual scholarship program AND get free advertising of your skills and wares. **Special note: Show donations are not tax deductible.**

For artists who donate work needing framing, **Picture This** will frame the donated art at cost. **Picture This** will also shrink wrap prints at no cost to the artist. Unframed artwork is also kindly welcomed!

No theme is required. Old work, new work, whatever handmade work the artist wishes to donate will be graciously accepted!

The **FREEDOM FOR ALL** art show celebrates ALL personal freedoms -- our right to make choices about our own body, who we love, who we lift up, and who we choose to associate with -- whatever those freedoms may be. Bonus points for artists who donate handmade work representing what **FREEDOM FOR ALL** means to you!

There are **no size requirements**. Go as big or small as your mood strikes you. **Picture This** studio master Dez will figure out a way to display it! All types of handmade art are encouraged: two dimensional--paper, canvas, etc.; and three dimensional--fabric, sculpture, jewelry, etc.

Art show donations need to be delivered no later than:

May 2 – Work needing to be framed or shrink wrapped

May 19 – Work not needing to be framed or shrink wrapped
